ROLE PROFILE:

The position is responsible for promoting HIAA's cargo services and land development opportunities. In addition, will be focused on building relationships with existing and potential air cargo operators, real estate developers and general land tenants with the objective to increase both non-aeronautical and aeronautical revenue from HIAA cargo flights. Key activities include preparing business cases and developing general marketing and networking opportunities for cargo and real estate development at HIAA. In addition this role will assist in negotiating and preparing all contractual documents with respect to land leasing, special licenses, and Air Carrier Operating Agreements (ACOA) with cargo airlines.

FORMAL EDUCATION / TRAINING:

- Undergraduate degree in a related discipline.
- At least four years of combined job-related experience in the cargo and real estate industries.
- In-depth knowledge and experience of the cargo industry including general knowledge of air transport regulations; understanding of various air services guidelines acts and regulations.
- Understanding of available and required aircraft and ground support equipment required for air cargo operations.
- Understanding of the transshipment program, the movement of products through the cargo logistical chain and the freight forwarding process (FTZ Program).
- Strong background in real estate and development processes including contract negotiations and lease preparations.
- General knowledge of site development, site planning and construction practices is an asset.
- Comprehensive knowledge of, and/or ability to quickly absorb relevant municipal, provincial and federal legislation, regulations and policies.
- Demonstrated ability to effectively communicate to different audiences
- Demonstrated ability to develop and maintain strategic working relationships with internal departments and external stakeholders
- Demonstrated ability to make decisions
- Strong computer skills and experience with MS Office and Outlook
