

Regional Airport Manager Government of Northwest Territories – Department of Infrastructure Yellowknife, NT

Department Information

The Department of Infrastructure (INF) provides high quality services to the public and Government of the Northwest Territories' (GNWT) departments, boards and agencies including the planning, design, construction, acquisition, operation and maintenance of public transportation infrastructure and the buildings, works and equipment required for the GNWT to deliver its programs and services. INF makes essential petroleum products available for sale to the public where these products are not provided by the private sector, and promotes the development and increased use of energy efficient technologies. INF also regulates electrical and mechanical safety services and licenses individuals and vehicles operating in the territory. Yellowknife Airport serves as the primary aviation gateway to communities within the North and is one of the 26 airports in Canada included in the National Airports System (NAS). The NAS is defined by TC as those strategic infrastructure assets essential to Canada's air transportation system. Yellowknife Airport plays a major role in supporting industry, tourism and the overall quality of life in the North. Air transportation is recognized by GNWT as an essential component of the implementation of its strategic activities.

Job Information

The Regional Airport Manager plans, manages and directs airport operations at Yellowknife Airport as well as for four (4) Community Airports to ensure serviceability of all airport facilities, maximize revenues, improve commercial viability, and ensure the implementation of emergency, safety & security programs. The operating budget managed by this position is over \$6 million with revenue of approximately10 million.

Typically, the above qualifications would be attained by:

Post-secondary education in Business Administration or other relevant disciplines,

complemented by additional education in a field related to airport planning, operations and

management; and

Minimum of 5 years directly related experience in operations of NAS or equivalent airports

including commercial property administration, supervising trades persons and other airport

operations specialists.

The salary range for this position is from \$56.15 per hour to \$67.03 per hour (approximately

\$109493 - \$130,709.) plus an annual Northern Allowance of \$3,450.
